Fun Ways to Play with a Calculator

- Your child can just push the buttons.
It is okay if your child wants to push the buttons, over and over again.
It is fun to see the numbers come up on the screen.
- Can your child tell you some of the numbers on the screen?
- Ask your child, "How old are you?"
Can your child make that number come up on the screen?
- Your child can play store or restaurant with the calculator.
Your child can pretend to add things to tell how much they cost.

What Your Child Learns from a Calculator

Just looking at numbers on the calculator buttons or on the screen will help your child learn what numbers look like. Children also like to feel "grownup" when they use something that grownups use.
