## Deck of Cards

Cards can give your child a fun way to learn about numbers and sorting.

### Sorting Games

There are lots of different ways to sort cards:

#### By Color:

- Can your child put all the red ones in one pile and all the black ones in another pile?

#### By Number:

- Can your child make piles of all the cards with the same number? Tell your child that Aces in cards are like the number 1. Can your child put the piles in order of Ace, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9?

#### By Picture Cards:

- Can your child sort all the Jacks in one pile, the Queens in one pile, and the Kings in another pile?

### What Your Child Learns from Playing with Cards

Just looking at the cards can help your child learn about numbers.

### More Fun Ways to Use Cards

- Can your child pick two cards with numbers, and say which number is bigger?
- Sometimes children like to make up their own games with cards. Encourage your child and play along.
